Finding Swan Valley Herbs:

On Hwy 35, turn east (right if going north; left if going south) at the main stoplight (at Flathead Bank), onto Grand Ave. Follow the main drag, past Bigfork Schools; at the bottom of the hill on the left is an office building with the UPS store at the west end, and Swan Vally Herbs at the east end. A block past the herb store is the Bigfork Inn and the turn to Electric Ave, Bigfork's main street.

Finding the Harry Horn Day Use area:

- Driving south on Hwy 35, past the intersection with Hwy 209 (blinking light), past the Lutheran Church, Rosa's Pizza and Burgertown on the left, look for the next right and the sign for Wayfarer's Park. If you get to the entrance to Averill's Flathead Lake Lodge, you've gone too far.
- **Driving north** on Hwy 35, look for the sign for Wayfarer's Park on the left; it is the next left after the entrance to Averill's Flathead Lake Lodge. If you get to Burgertown and Rosa's Pizza (on the right), you've gone too far.
- After turning at the Wayfarer's Park sign, you will enter the Harry Horn Day Use and parking area.
